A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDING ASSISTANCE TO THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR THE PRENTICE AVENUE/FENNIMORE STREET HALF-WIDTH ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.


WHEREAS, the City of Gig Harbor intends to implement half-width roadway improvements for pedestrian flow and public safety on Prentice Avenue and Fennimore Street; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program, grant assistance may be available to aid in financing the cost of sidewalk improvements from Harbor Ridge Middle School along Prentice Avenue to Fennimore Street, and then along Fennimore Street to Peacock Hill Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Gig Harbor:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application(s) to the Safe Routes to School Program for grant assistance for the Prentice Avenue/Fennimore Street Half-Width Roadway Improvements Project.
