

ORDINANCE NO. 958

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO LAND USE AND ZONING, ADDING HOSPITALS AS CONDITIONALLY ALLOWED USES IN THE PLANNED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT – BUSINESS PARK (PCD-BP) ZONE IN GIG HARBOR MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.54.025.

WHEREAS, the intent of the Planned Community Development – Business Park (PCD-BP) zone is to discourage retail uses in order that it might be preserved for major employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, hospitals generally provide major employment opportunities; and

WHEREAS, allowing hospitals is consistent with the intent of the PCD-BP zone; and

WHEREAS, allowing hospitals as conditional uses ensures that aesthetic, environmental, and buffering concerns will be addressed on a site specific basis with more detail than allowed through the typical site plan and design review process; and

WHEREAS, the City's SEPA Responsible Official has made a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for this Ordinance on February 16, 2004; and

WHEREAS, no appeals of the DNS were filed with the City; and

WHEREAS, the City sent a copy of this Ordinance to the Washington State Office of Community, Trade and Development on December 17, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission held a public hearing on this Ordinance on January 15, 2004; and recommended approval to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, on February 23rd and March 8, 2004, the City Council considered this Ordinance during a regular meeting; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section 17.54.025 of the Gig Harbor Municipal Code is hereby adopted to read as follows:

17.54.025 Conditional Uses.

Subject to the requirements of Chapter 17.64 GHMC and the procedures for conditional uses as set forth in this title, the following uses may be permitted in a PCD-BP district:

A. Hospitals.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary consisting of the title.
