That pursuant to the Revised Code of Washington, Sec. 35.21.180, the standard of the National Board of Fire Underwriters for the storage and handling and use of flammable liquids as recommended by the National Fire Protection Association as adopted June 1959 in Pamphlet NBFU No. 30, be and it is hereby adopted by The Town of Gig Harbor as and for the law relating to said subjects within said Town.

Sec. 2. That three copies of the said Pamphlet and compilation have been filed with the Clerk of the Town of Gig Harbor, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 35.21.180.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
