AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, VACATING THE PORTION OF SWEENEY WAY, LYING EAST OF PEACOCK HILL AVENUE AND WEST OF NORTH HARBORVIEW DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the referenced portion of right of way is undeveloped, and

WHEREAS, the referenced portion of right of way is not necessary to the street and circulation plans of the city and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution No. 266 initiating the procedure for the vacation of the referenced street and setting a hearing date, and

WHEREAS, after the required public notice had been given the City Council conducted a public hearing on the matter on February 12, 1990, and at the conclusion of such hearing determined that the aforementioned right-of-way should be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Gig Harbor, Washington, **ORDAINS** as follows:

Section 1. The portion of the street currently known as Sweeney Way, originally platted as Kalama Avenue in Gig Harbor, which lies east of the street currently known as Peacock Hill Avenue and originally platted as Skagit Street, as shown on the plat filed on August 30, 1890, denominated as the Town of Artona, Pierce County, Washington, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full, is hereby vacated.

The abutting property owners shall compensate the City of Gig Harbor for the value of the property at \$8,500 in exchange of the city vacating the above referenced property.

The City of Gig Harbor shall retain a utility easement of 15 feet in the above referenced property for construction and maintenance purposes of city utilities, centered on center line.

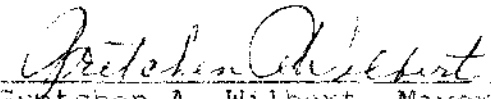
Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Pierce County Auditor.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect five days after passage and publication as required by law.

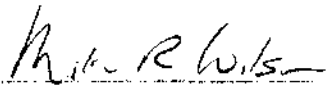
