ORDINANCE NO. 92

Guidelines Establishing Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction

The Town Council and the Town Engineers have considered the needs of the Town of Gig Harbor for extended negotiations for municipal public works construction and Utilities. The Town Council has also considered the public welfare of the Town of Gig Harbor.

Therefore, Be It Ordained
by the Council of the Town of Gig
Hut, Pierce County, Washing-
ton,

Secondly. That the Town Council
effort for the standard specifica-
tions for municipal public works
be discontinued.

Standard Test the Town Council shall be in violation except by reference thereto when amplified prepared by the Washington State Chapter of American Public Works Association and distributed by the Standard of Washington Cities and Towns Indian well the Bureau of Standard Research and Service University of Washington, known as the Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction, prepared in 1963.

Section 3. That upon the passage of the resolution adopting the specifications for municipal public works construction as set forth in the before mentioned pamphlet, the Town Clerk shall maintain a copy of said pamphlet in the public records of the Town of Gig Harbor and a pamphlet shall be subject to inspection by the public.

Section 4. That upon the passage of the resolution adopting the aforesaid pamphlet, all major public works construction shall be subject to the specifications set forth in said pamphlet and the Town Council shall have the power to enjoin said specifications by civil injunctive relief.
