

RESOLUTION NO. 728

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, TO INITIATE THE PROCEDURE FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PRENTICE AVENUE AND BENSON STREET.

WHEREAS, Todd Block desires to initiate the procedure for the vacation of the portion of Prentice Avenue and Benson Street, a portion of the original plat of the Woodworth's Addition to Gig Harbor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Gig Harbor, Washington:

Section 1. A public hearing upon said street vacation shall be held in the council chambers of Gig Harbor Civic Center on Monday, October 22, 2007 at 6:00 p.m., at which hearing all persons interested in said street vacation are invited to appear.

Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to post notices of the hearing in three public places and on the street to be vacated and to mail notices to all owners of any property abutting the portion of street to be vacated, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020.
