**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON WHICH
ESTABLISHES FEES FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY USE PERMITS AND SETS FORTH
LIMITS OF REQUIRED PUBLIC LIABILITY/PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE
REQUIREMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH RIGHT-OF-WAY USE PERMITS**

WHEREAS, the City of Gig Harbor desires to establish such fees by Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
GIG HARBOR AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Right-of-Way Use Permits are established as follows:

| A. | Residential (Fence/Retaining Walls) - Indefinite | \$ 50.00 |
| B. | Commercial (one year term) | \$ 50.00 |
| C. | Temporary (30-day term) | \$ 25.00 |

Section 2. Revocation In the event Right-of-Way Use Permit is revoked by the Director of Public Works, as provided by Ordinance, there shall be no refund of the Right-of-Way Use Permit Fees set forth in Section 1.

Section 3. A Right-of-Way Permit for temporary and commercial permits will not be issued until applicant has provided to the Director of Public Works a certificate evidencing the existence of public liability and property damage in the following minimum limits and naming the City of Gig Harbor as an additional insured:

Bodily Injury Liability \$300,000
Property Damage Liability \$300,000
OR
Combined Single Limit Bodily
Injury and Property Damage \$600,000
