

RESOLUTION NO. 173

**A RESOLUTION** relating to extension of water and sewer services: amending Resolution No. 164 to delete and replace obsolete references therein.

**WHEREAS**, the Gig Harbor City Council determined that the City should not extend utilities to properties where the land use is not compatible with the City's comprehensive land use plan; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires a balance between the implied objectives in Resolution 164; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

The City Council for the City of Gig Harbor **DO RESOLVE** the following:


Section 1.

Section 8C of Resolution No. 164 is amended as follows:  
"C. Extended lines ((shall-not-by-pass-intervening properties-to-service-proposed-properties-(commonly known-as-the-"leap-frog"-effect)) may by-pass intervening properties for the first quarter-of-a-mile outside the City limits to service proposed properties. Beyond the distance intervening properties must participate in the extension."

Section 2.

Section 8D of Resolution No. 164 is amended as follows:  
"D. Proposed use of the property to which service is extended shall comply with ((Pierce-County-land-use regulations)). The City of Gig Harbor's comprehensive land use plan and zoning regulations."
