

## RESOLUTION 1345

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, APPROVING 2026 LODGING TAX EXPENDITURES

---

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 67.28 of the Revised Code of Washington and Chapter 3.27 of the Gig Harbor Municipal Code authorizes the city to collect an excise tax on lodging, which tax is to be used for tourist promotion; and,

**WHEREAS**, the city council established a lodging tax advisory committee in GHMC Chapter 2.53 to make recommendations to council for expenditure of the funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, on September 23, 2025, the committee adopted its recommendations for 2026;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Gig Harbor:

**Section 1.** The city council adopts the 2026 recommendations for recipients and expenditures of lodging tax revenues in substantially the same form as at Exhibit A.

**Section 2.** The mayor is authorized to enter into agreements with the recipients of these revenues up to the amounts authorized by this resolution.
