

RESOLUTION NO. 1110

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE NAME CHANGE FOR FOX RUN PLAT TO THE TRACE AT FOX RUN, LOCATED AT 5713 38TH AVENUE NORTHWEST AND RELATED TO CITY OF GIG HARBOR FILE NO. PL-FPLAT-17-0001.

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2017, the City Council passed Resolution No. 1107 approving the final plat application for Fox Run Plat, File No. PL-FPLAT-17-0001; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 65.04.050, the Auditor's Office shall not receive for record any plat bearing a name the same or similar to the name of any plat already on record in the office; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2017, the developer's representative informed the City that the name Fox Run was already used elsewhere in Pierce County and that the developer has requested to change the name to The Trace at Fox Run; Now Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby acknowledges and approves the name change for Fox Run Plat, File No. PL-FPLAT-17-0001, to The Trace at Fox Run; subject to the following conditions:

1. The final plat at Sheet 1 of 4 shall be modified prior to recording to reflect that the plat was originally approved as "Fox Run Plat."

Section 2. The City Council directs the Mayor and all other appropriate City officials to inscribe and execute the City's written approval on the face of the revised plat.

Section 3. The City shall record the final plat with the County Auditor, at the expense of the applicant, after all inspections and approvals, and after all fees, charges and assessments due the City resulting from the subdivision development have been paid in full.


